

## What are some Early Warning Signs?

You notice that your child:

- \* Short attention span
- \* Hyperactivity
- \* Slow & difficult to understand speech
- \* Doesn't respond to noises
- \* Turns radio/TV too loud
- \* Can't locate or pick up small objects
- \* Cannot repeat simple nursery rhymes
- \* Is slower developing than peers
- \* No communication
- \* Has a general pervasive mood of unhappiness or depression
- \* Poor coordination
- \* Distractibility
- \* Appears not to pay attention
- \* Frequent ear aches
- \* Frequently asks speaker to repeat
- \* Holds materials close to face
- \* Cannot retell a story in proper sequence
- \* Inappropriate types of behavior or feelings under normal circumstances

## What is Child Find?

Caroline County Public Schools participate in an ongoing process of locating, identifying and evaluating children between the ages of birth through twenty-one who are suspected of having a disability.

Any Child who is identified as having a disability is entitled to a free, appropriate education which is designed to meet his/her needs. Special Education programs are available for children with disabilities in Caroline County.

Multiple Disabilities  
Orthopedic Impairments  
Other Health Impairments  
Serious Emotional Disturbance

Speech/Language Impairments  
Traumatic Brain Injury  
Visual Impairments



Ages: 2 to 5

Referrals can be made by anyone concerned with the child's educational functioning including the child's teacher, parent, community agency or the school officials.
